

Parks duties:

All year: fill dog pot dispensers. March thru September check monthly
October thru February, bi monthly works

Spring:

Call TLC to have Porta A John placed at Mountain Lion (April thru November)
406-388-7696 (they have us on an auto schedule)

Call L&L Site Service to restart bi-weekly garbage pick up at Mountain Lion
(March thru November) 406-388-7171. The trash will need to be moved
from the park container and placed into the L&L can and moved to the curb
Thursday night and after pick up on Friday the trash can needs placed into the shed.
IF the can is not placed back into the shed people use it for house hold garbage.
Trooper Poopers will not empty this can because it has other trash in it.
Will need to call them to put us on a hold for the winter.

Mountain Lion Sprinklers: Old Faithful will email the date for turn on.

Email Pete to turn the water on at the street.

Pond Sprinklers are also turned on by Old Faithful at the same time.

Old Faithful will also do blow out, again they will email the date this is to be done

Turn off the controllers at both locations. Email Pete to turn off the water at
the street prior to Old Faithful blowing out the systems

Call Pond Doctor to turn on pond aerators. 406-579-6956. November before the pond freezes,
turn off the aerators.

At the end of winter need to inspect playground equipment, dock and out buildings to see if any
repairs are needed. (painting, woodchips at MT Lion) Woodchips are a certain type, purchased
from Wester Pines, usually ever 5 years. They do not spread them, so volunteers will be needed.

Pond Trees.

To prevent sun scold and to protect the Canadian Cherry trees, tree wrap is put on Mid-
October and removed sometime in April. The wrap material is in the shed at the pond.

Pond Drips: I check on a regular basis. The drip heads come off and need replaced. Old Faithful
charges \$100 hourly. So to save money I just check them, extra parts are in the pond shed.

The picnic area at Mountain Lion, because of the well pump no weed killer can be used. I
purchase an 80 pound bag of course water softener salt and sprinkle around the picnic area and
swing area, just before a rain April and May (might take 2 bags) I also salt the entrance at
Maverick to prevent weeds.

So far I have not been able to find anyone to pull weeds or to cut the Canadian Cherry tree
shoots, therefore I have been doing it.

When trees or willows need trimmed Mountain Arbor Works, Chris 406-570-6116 works within
our budget. His prices are very reasonable.

Mountain Pump Company has replaced the pump at the pond for the drip system to the trees
406-388-1134 (he knows the system) pump is 50 feet into the pond.

Noxious Weeds: Mark 406 Weeds 406-640-2232 sprays along McDonald Creek (near pond)
